- Supporting, consulting and communicating with all workers through our environmental consultative mechanism(s), and ensure the workforce is informed regarding environmental requirements.
- Adopt environmental risk management principles to assess project environmental risks and implement appropriate risk management programs as a means of continual improvement;
- Environmental aspect identification, risk assessment and risk control to eliminate and / or reduce the risk of environmental impact;
- Monitor review and evaluate environmental risk controls affecting the environment of workers and the community;
- Continually review and improve our policies and procedures to maintain protection of the environment of workers, visitors and community;

This policy and supporting specialized environmental management policies, serve to enhance the framework for setting and reviewing the objectives and targets for environmental management and performance and to recognize all input in this regard. In turn it is the responsibility of all who engage with Moore Management whether management, workers or visitors to:

- Adhere to Moore Management environmental management systems, policies and procedures;
